

Supporting Your Birth Complete Care Plan \$5000

- In depth initial prenatal visit, 1.5- 2 hours
- All routine prenatal visits, 45-60 minutes each (every 4 weeks until 28 weeks; every 2 weeks from 28-36 weeks, every week from 36 weeks until birth).
- Random glucose screen at home at 26-28 weeks.
- Organic teas for pregnancy, labor, postpartum
- Initial visit with Pelvic Floor Therapist
- Follow up visit with PFT OR massage, prenatally
- Supply List (for non sterile supplies)
- Inflatable pool (single use)
- Birth Kit (for sterile supplies)
- Labor and birth support (includes midwife and assistant).
- \$300 towards Doula Program
- Postpartum bath herbs
- Suturing of tears (with lidocaine) if needed.
- First Newborn Screen at 24-48 hours
- Registration of the birth certificate with Arizona Vital Statistics.
- Private in-home visit from an IBCLC in first week postpartum (2-3 hours)
- All postpartum visits 45-60 minutes each (for home birth, typically 1 day, 3-5 days, 10-14 days if needed, and 5 weeks).
- Follow up postpartum visits with Pelvic Floor Therapist (x2)

What costs are not included?

- *Pap smear
- Blood work
- Vitamins or supplements
- *Genetic Screening (MSAFP)
- Ultrasound, at least one recommended
- *Perinatal consult(s) for higher risk situations.
- *Non-stress test or BioPhysical Profile to check on baby's wellbeing in utero
- *Costs associated with hospital transfer or hospital care
- Vitamin K and/or *Erythromycin eye ointment if desired
- Recommended Pediatrician visit 1-2 weeks postpartum
- Newborn Hearing Screen (free location available)

^{*}Uncommon, but possible depending on your history and pregnancy health.
